

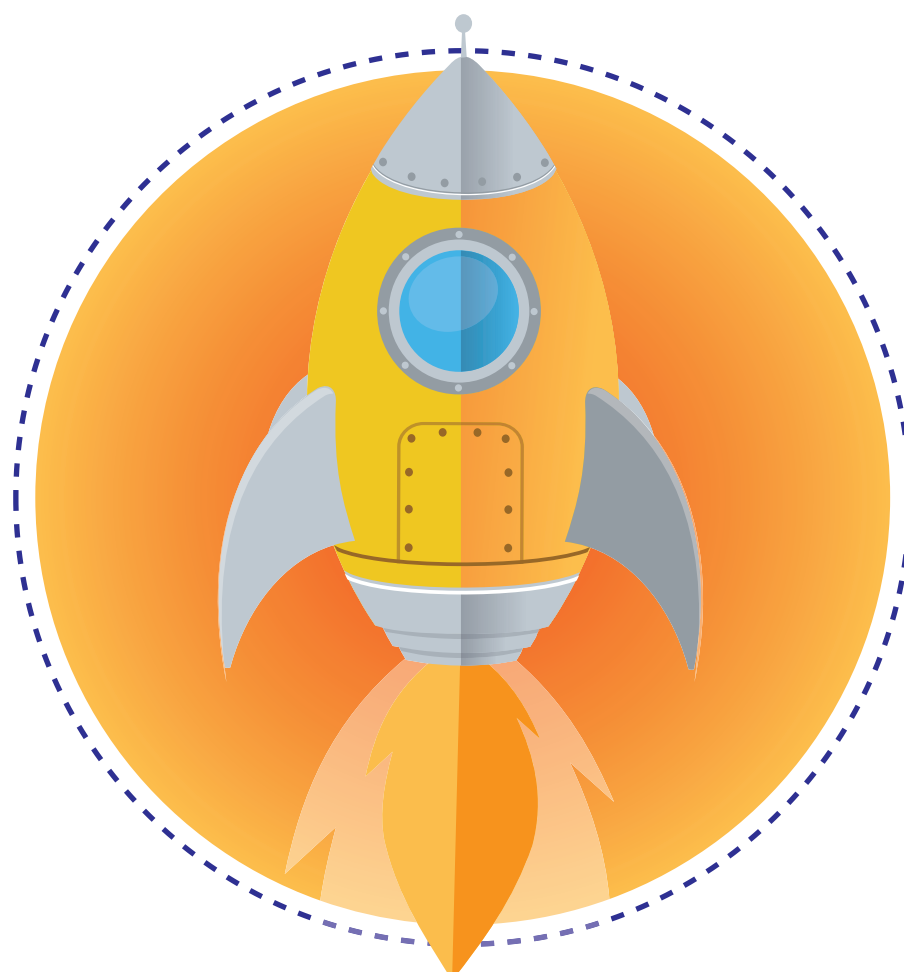

BEHAVIOUR

- Disrespectful (including rudeness and defiance)
- Physical violence
- Uses 'bad words' and inappropriate language
- Doesn't look after property
- Doesn't follow adult instructions
- Easily distracted and distracts other people and stops them from learning
- Talks over the teacher

Sometimes... But not always...

- Follows the 6 Rs and Golden Rules
- Listens to the teacher
- Polite without being prompted
- Respectful of others and property
- Follows adult instructions
- Positive attitude to learning
- Has courage and determination to rise to challenges and take risks
- Is a good team player (pupils and all grown-ups)

EFFORT

- Untidy/Unfinished work
- Gives up and doesn't try
- Always goes for the easy option
- Doesn't try anything new or challenging
- Closed mindset "I can't do it"
- Little or no attempt made

Sometimes... But not always...

- High expectations whether working independently or guided by the teacher
- High productivity
- Makes improvements in work
- Tries to do more than expected
- Brings in homework/takes home reading book
- Continues to learn at home even if the teacher has not requested this
- Has a growth mind set "I will try"

READINESS TO LEARN (PUNCTUALITY)

- Silly/distracting behaviour
- Procrastinates
- Talking when not supposed to be
- Not contributing ideas and questions to discussions
- Asked to line up properly
- Slow coming to the carpet/tables
- Doesn't look after resources
- Late in the morning
- Last in at playtime

Sometimes... But not always...

- Understands and reflects the 6Rs in all aspects of learning
- On time and ready to learn
- Has the right tools for the job
- Sits on the carpet/at tables quickly. Lines up appropriately
- Ignores silly behaviour, makes the right choices
- Doesn't need reminding
- Whole body listening
- Keen to share ideas and ask questions
- Will have a go and learn from mistakes

UNIFORM

- Casual clothing
- Bright coloured trainers
- Jewellery
- Hoodies
- Sportswear
- Leggings

Sometimes... But not always...

- Navy coloured school sweatshirt
- Black or grey trousers/skirt/shorts
- White polo shirt
- Sensible shoes
- Black, navy or grey tights/socks
- Blue/White gingham dress
- For indoor PE; navy shorts, white or navy T-shirt and trainers or plimsols.
- For outdoor PE; a tracksuit or sweatshirt may be worn in cold weather, trainers
