

HOMEWORK POLICY

Date policy was last reviewed and approved:

At Hemingford Grey Primary School we aim to inspire learning by providing a wide variety of challenges and tasks across the curriculum. Learning will be seamless through pre-learning and reviewing learning both at home and at school. Opportunities for learning will be open ended so that all children can access and complete them. Homework will be monitored and celebrated in school.

Key Stage Two Learning Log:

The Learning Log sets a fortnightly challenge which is linked to an aspect of the theme or an element of the news. Children in Key Stage 2 are encouraged to respond as creatively as possible. This could include a written response to the challenge, an artistic impression stuck in the Log, a photograph of a model made or a place visited, or something created using ICT and uploaded onto Edmodo. These efforts are celebrated on a fortnightly basis in class, with children sharing their successes with their peers and teacher in a 'homework gallery'.

- Teachers will stamp the page to demonstrate they have seen it and appraised it as part of the gallery.
- **Key Stage One** have termly creative projects linked to their theme.
